WALK II

YARDLEY GOBION & ALONG THE GRAND UNION CANAL

A very pleasant easy walk, including a stretch along the Grand Union Canal towpath. There are also stunning views from the village of Grafton Regis, enjoyed by royalty in the form of Henry VIII who often stayed here.

1 There is plenty of parking at The Coffee Pot. Head right out of pub car park, out of village and turn left at road junction, down to main road which cross with care. The footpath is just to the right where you cross a stile and follow across field, down hill to canal.

2 Cross bridge and turn left onto towpath which you follow for just over two miles until reaching road bridge.

3 Turn left over bridge and up steep hill to Grafton Regis. Fork left at junction in village. Option to stop at White Hart (turn right at main road).

4 Cross road and look for footpath which starts just behind Grafton Regis signpost. Cross field, over wooden bridge and up to track. Walk past bungalows to stile on left and cross field towards lake.

5 Cross over stile and follow path to gate, pass through and turn left then right and head up hill passing reed fringed lake on left. Cross stile next to gate and follow path back to village, over two more stiles and then follow main street through village back to pub.
