Start & finish: "The Trout" Godstow Road, Wolvercote OX2 8PN

This is a well-known circular walk from the Trout Inn Godstow/Oxford (approx 5 miles/ 2 ½ hours), it can be shortened, and is all on the flat no stiles. You walk along the River Thames on an easy path towards Oxford, once in Oxford a left turn and head back up along the canal, again a lovely canal walk, barges etc back to the Village of Godstow to the Trout Inn for lunch. The Trout has an extensive menu, from soup/ sandwich /snacks to full meals (we will pre order on the day, attached menu), it's a lovely setting and will be very busy if it's a nice day. <https://www.thetroutoxford.co.uk/lunchmenu>

DIRECTIONS – Journey time approx 40 mins

The key is to head towards Oxford on the A34 to the Pear tree roundabout interchange. From Buckingham take the road to Bicester (A4211), follow outer ring road (or go through the town) to the A41/(A34) signed Oxford. Cross the M40 heading down the A34 to Oxford. Take the slip road on to the Pear Tree roundabout (sign posted A44 Oxford/Evesham), head towards Oxford on the short dual carriage way. At the next roundabout (BP garage on right), take the 4th exit to Godstow. Proceed through Godstow, passing a number of pubs and you will come to the Trout car park on the right.
